Job Responsibilities:

Under the supervision of the Environmental Health Director, conducts routine inspections at commercial, residential and public locations within the district for compliance with federal, state and local environmental health laws under the authority of the Health Officer to safeguard the public health and environment. Primary functions of this position will be focused in the on-site wastewater, drinking water, and land development programs including inspections of water well and septic systems for real estate transactions. A professional public health advocate and educator are key components to this position. Additional responsibilities will include audits of public institutions such as campgrounds, swimming pools, public beaches, body art, care facilities, and other assigned duties. Facilitate positive collaboration with other public health stakeholders including MDARD, MDEQ and MDHHS. This position requires high degrees of both written and oral communication skills engaging with the public as a representative of the Health Department. Must have the ability to make sound, independent judgement as it relates to public health, safety and welfare.

Minimum Qualifications:

The successful candidate will be a Registered Sanitarian, possess a Bachelor's degree in Environmental Health or a related science field. A minimum of three to five years' experience as a sanitarian permitting and inspecting drinking water well systems and on-site sewage disposal systems is required. Knowledge of the Michigan Criteria for Subsurface Sewage Disposal is expected. Solid knowledge of water well construction is important. Must understand principles and best practices of Environmental Health Sanitation and how they interact with Public Health laws and regulations. A valid, unrestricted Michigan driver's license and dependable transportation to perform the job duties is required. Computer literacy and knowledge of word processing software is mandatory. Strong work ethic and a positive attitude shall be expected.
