## The Benzie-Leelanau District Health Department COVID-19 Update

Today there were seven new cases of COVID-19 reported in Benzie County and three new cases of COVID-19 reported in Leelanau County.

"Over the last few weeks, we have seen a decrease in our case rates that is encouraging," said Dr. Josh Meyerson. "As we continue to host vaccination clinics and get doses in arms, I am optimistic that the worst is behind us. The MI Vacc to Normal, and increased vaccinations statewide, is a great challenge for us all! We all want to get there, and we all want to take our masks off, and enjoy the summer in Michigan."

"Getting vaccinated is the best way to protect yourself, your family, and your community – and enjoy the full freedoms of being fully vaccinated," Peacock said. The health department is offering walk-in vaccinations or people can make an appointment at <u>www.bldhd.org</u>. Additional vaccination sites can be found at <u>vaccines.gov</u>. Residents can choose the date and location for their appointment.

- Number of vaccine doses administered so far this week: 600 doses.
- Total number of vaccine doses distributed to other providers: 1,054 doses.
- Total number of vaccine doses administered: 16,390 doses.
- Total number of vaccine doses received: 18,672 doses.

As of 4:00 p.m. today, the Benzie-Leelanau District Health Department is reporting:

- Total COVID-19 cases in the following counties: Benzie– 1,225, Leelanau– 1,230
- Active COVID-19 cases in the following counties: Benzie– 173, Leelanau– 123
- Recovered COVID-19 cases in the following counties: Benzie– 1,020, Leelanau– 1,091
- Confirmed COVID-19 deaths in the following counties: Benzie 32, Leelanau– 16
- Hospitalized: 153 total; 2 currently

The State of Michigan is reporting 860,808 cases and 18,084 deaths.
