### **The Benzie-Leelanau District Health Department COVID-19 Update**

Today there were zero new cases of COVID-19 reported in Benzie County and one new case of COVID-19 reported in Leelanau County. The Benzie-Leelanau District Health Department has reported 3 new cases – 2 new cases in Benzie County and 1 new case in Leelanau County - of COVID-19 since Friday, May 28th. Saturday, May 29th, 1 new case was reported in Benzie County. Sunday, May 30th, 1 new case were reported in Benzie County. One new COVID-19 related death was reported in Benzie County of a female resident in her 90's.

Despite the number of COVID-19 cases declining across the Benzie-Leelanau District Health Department, health officials remind people that attending gatherings to celebrate summer, graduations, proms, and other end of the school year events increases the risk people getting and spreading COVID-19. [If you are fully vaccinated](#), you can resume activities without generally wearing a mask or physically distancing.

However, even if you've been fully vaccinated, keep doing the following while attending gatherings to further protect yourself and those around you:

- Follow any mask guidance in place at local facilities, workplaces, and businesses.
- If you [travel](#), you should still take steps to [protect yourself and others](#). You will still be [required to wear](#) a mask on planes, buses, trains, and public transportation.
- Watch out for [symptoms of COVID-19](#), especially if you've been around someone who is sick. If you have symptoms of COVID-19, you should get [tested](#) and [stay home and away](#) from others.
- If you have a condition or are taking medications that weaken the immune system, talk to your healthcare provider. You may need to keep taking all [precautions](#) to prevent COVID-19.

"We are very pleased with the decline in case numbers but want to keep this level of cases low," said Lisa Peacock, Health Officer. "To do so, we need to do a number of things such as get vaccinated, be aware of your surroundings and take appropriate mediation measures, and lastly, get tested if you have any symptoms of COVID."

Still need to get vaccinated? The health department continues to offer vaccination clinics throughout the two-county jurisdiction, in addition to working with local businesses to offer pop-up vaccination clinics. Public health nurses are on site at these events and able to answer any questions that residents may have regarding the vaccines. All clinics are open to walk-ins or people can register by clicking on the clinic link below.

- Active COVID-19 cases in the following counties: Benzie– 48, Leelanau– 44
- Recovered COVID-19 cases in the following counties: Benzie– 1,168, Leelanau– 1,197
- Confirmed COVID-19 deaths in the following counties: Benzie – 33, Leelanau– 16
- Hospitalized: 158 total; 0 currently

The State of Michigan is reporting 888,581 cases and 19,176 deaths.
