The Benzie-Leelanau District Health Department COVID-19 Update

Today there were four new cases of COVID-19 reported in Benzie County and five new cases of COVID-19 reported in Leelanau County.

Since December 2020, when COVID-19 vaccination clinics began, the Benzie-Leelanau District Health Department has administered 11,150 total doses of COVID-19 vaccines.

As of March 28, the health department's vaccination status is as follows:

- Number of vaccine doses administered last week (March 22-28): 1,330 doses.
- Number of vaccine doses allocated for this week: 1,250 doses.
- Percent of Benzie and Leelanau county residents who have received at least one dose of a vaccine: 39.2%.
- Percent of Benzie and Leelanau county residents 65 and older who have received their first or initial dose: 62.2%.

"Today marked our 50th community based COVID-19 vaccine clinic in Benzie and Leelanau since December 2020! We are excited to continue to provide additional locations in the community and alternate options for those residents that need vaccine closer to home," stated Lisa Peacock, Health Officer.

As of 4:00pm, the Benzie-Leelanau District Health Department is reporting:

- Total COVID-19 cases in the following counties: Benzie– 977, Leelanau– 997
- Active COVID-19 cases in the following counties: Benzie– 78, Leelanau– 97
- Recovered COVID-19 cases in the following counties: Benzie– 868, Leelanau– 884
- Confirmed COVID-19 deaths in the following counties: Benzie – 31, Leelanau– 16
- Hospitalized: 136 total; 0 currently

The State of Michigan has reported 672,259 cases and 16,092 deaths.
