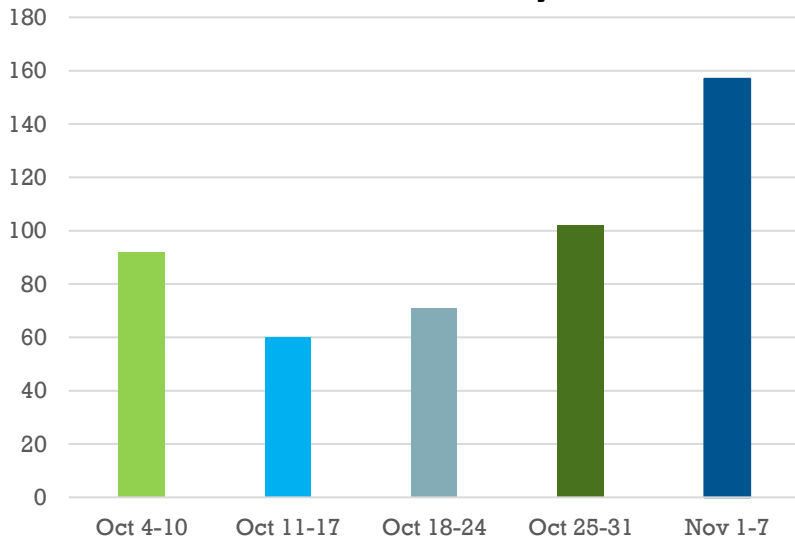


# Weekly Case Trend Summary

## Oct. 4, 2021 – Nov. 7, 2021

### Total New Cases by Week



### Data for all cases reported October 4 – November 7

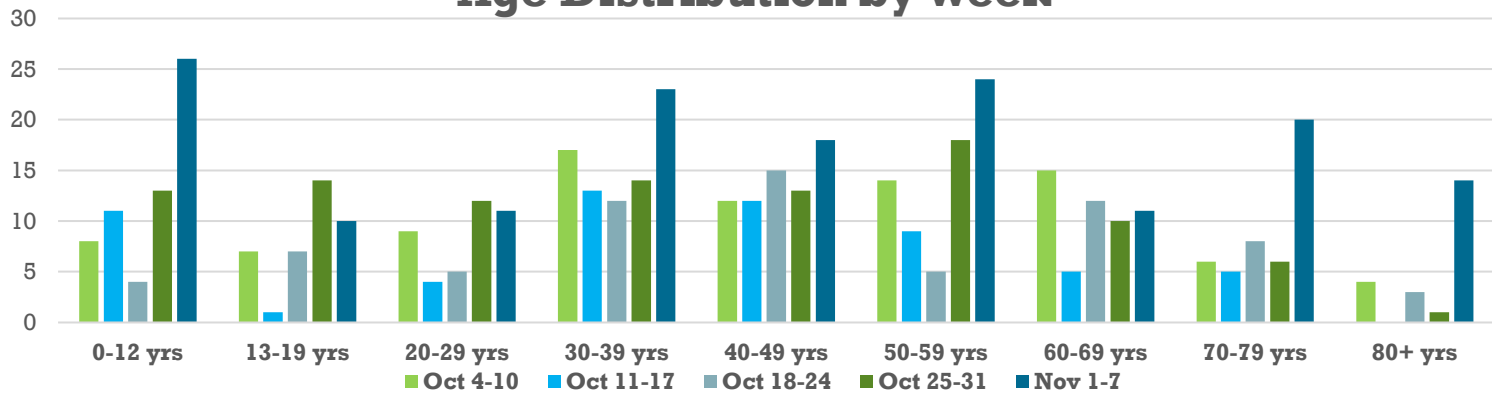
**89.0%** were symptomatic  
**3.1%** were asymptomatic  
**7.9%** did not report symptom status

Hospitalizations: **23 cases**  
Deaths: **3 cases**

**20.33%** of all cases reported fully vaccinated\* status.

February -November 5<sup>th</sup>, percentage of breakthrough\* cases: **1.02%**

### Case Data by Vaccination Status

From Oct. 4 – Nov. 7, the majority of cases were **not vaccinated** at the time of this report.

**79.7%**  
**NOT VACCINATED**

### Among unvaccinated cases:

**86.8%** were symptomatic  
**2.6%** were asymptomatic  
**10.6%** did not report symptom status

Hospitalizations: **19 cases**

Deaths: **2 cases**

**Fully vaccinated** individuals meet the following criteria:  
(1) 2 weeks after their second dose in a 2-dose series, such as the Pfizer or Moderna vaccines,  
**OR**  
(2) 2 weeks after a single-dose vaccine, such as Johnson & Johnson's Janssen vaccine.

**Not vaccinated/unvaccinated** includes those that do not meet the criteria of a fully vaccinated individual (outlined above).

**Breakthrough cases** are formally defined as the detection of SARS-CoV-2 RNA or antigen in a respiratory specimen collected from a person who is  $\geq 14$  days after completion all recommended doses of a U.S. Food and Drug Administration (FDA)-authorized COVID-19 vaccine.
