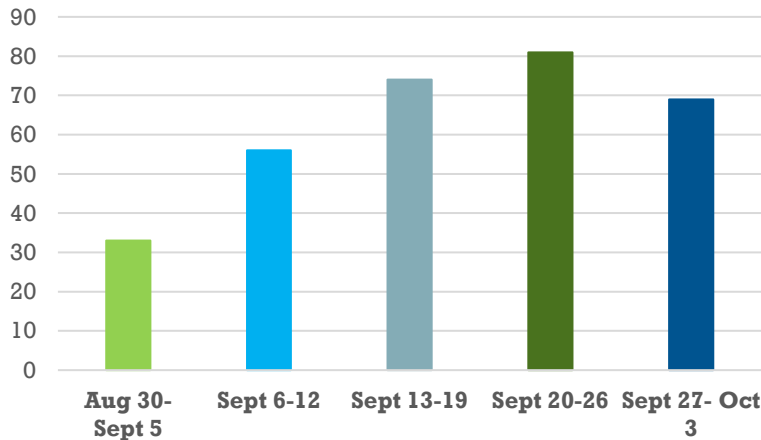


Weekly Case Trend Summary

Total New Cases by Week



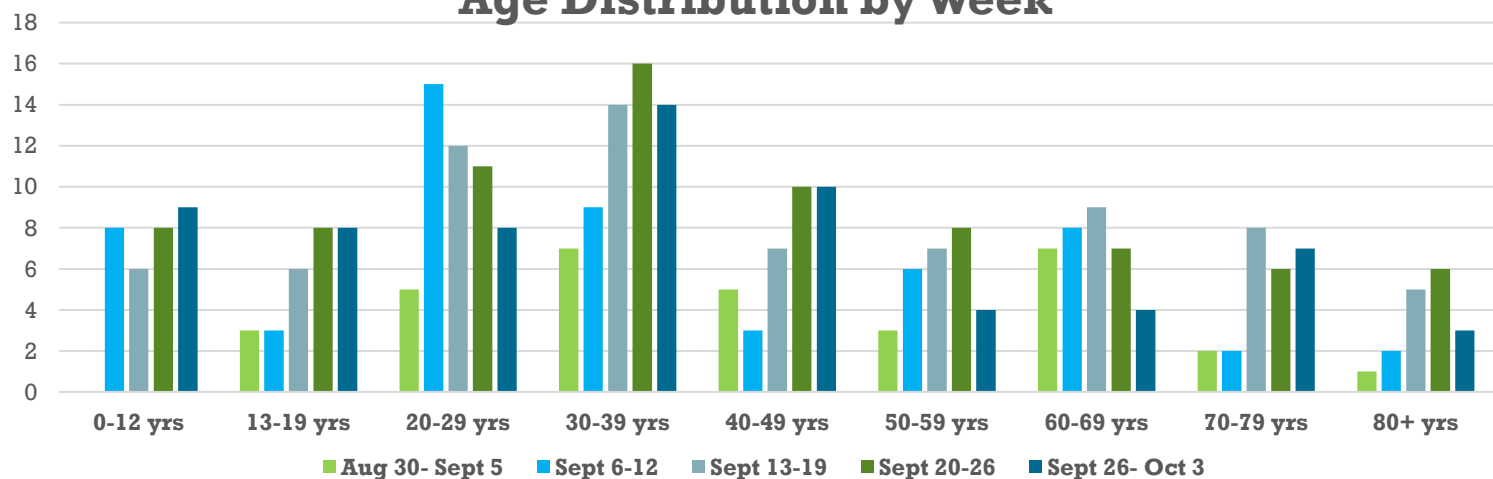

Between January 1, 2021 and September 28, 2021, there have been 117 fully vaccinated individuals diagnosed with COVID-19*.

Percentage of Breakthrough Infection

The average age of the breakthrough COVID-19 infections in Benzie-Leelanau was 57.9 years old.

Only 2 of these cases were submitted for genotyping, and both were returned with results for B.1.617.2 (Delta) variant infections

Fully vaccinated individuals meet the following criteria:
(1) 2 weeks after their second dose in a 2-dose series, such as the Pfizer or Moderna vaccines,
OR
(2) 2 weeks after a single-dose vaccine, such as Johnson & Johnson's Janssen vaccine.

Not vaccinated/unvaccinated includes those that do not meet the criteria of a fully vaccinated individual (outlined above).

Breakthrough cases are formally defined as the detection of SARS-CoV-2 RNA or antigen in a respiratory specimen collected from a person who is ≥ 14 days after completion all recommended doses of a U.S. Food and Drug Administration (FDA)-authorized COVID-19 vaccine.
