

COVID-19 BLDHD Monthly Summary – July 2021

The purpose of this monthly summary is to provide information regarding cases referred to the health department over the past month. Information is obtained through the Michigan Disease Surveillance System (MDSS). Data provided is for confirmed cases only unless otherwise noted as probable. *Starting November 24, 2020, we began reporting total COVID-19 cases, which includes the sum of confirmed and probable cases. This report reflects that change.

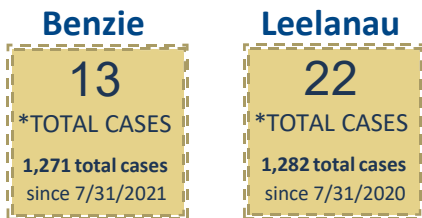
There was an increase in confirmed COVID-19 cases this month.



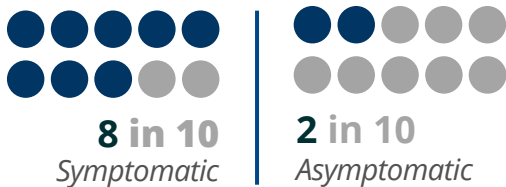
Known source of exposure has been identified for less than half of the cases.

July Cases by County

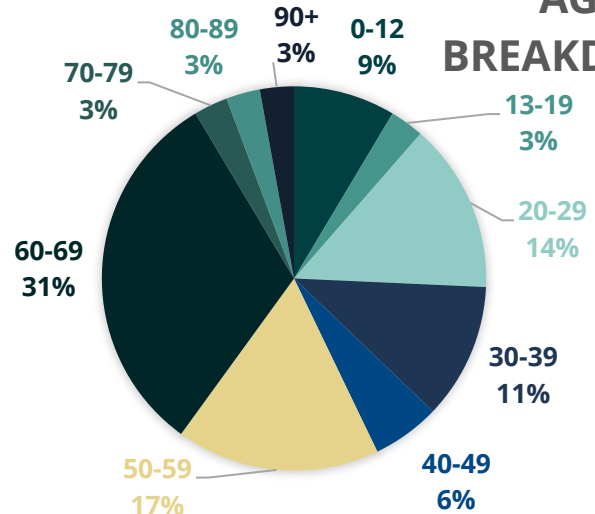


More than half of the cases were symptomatic during their course of illness.



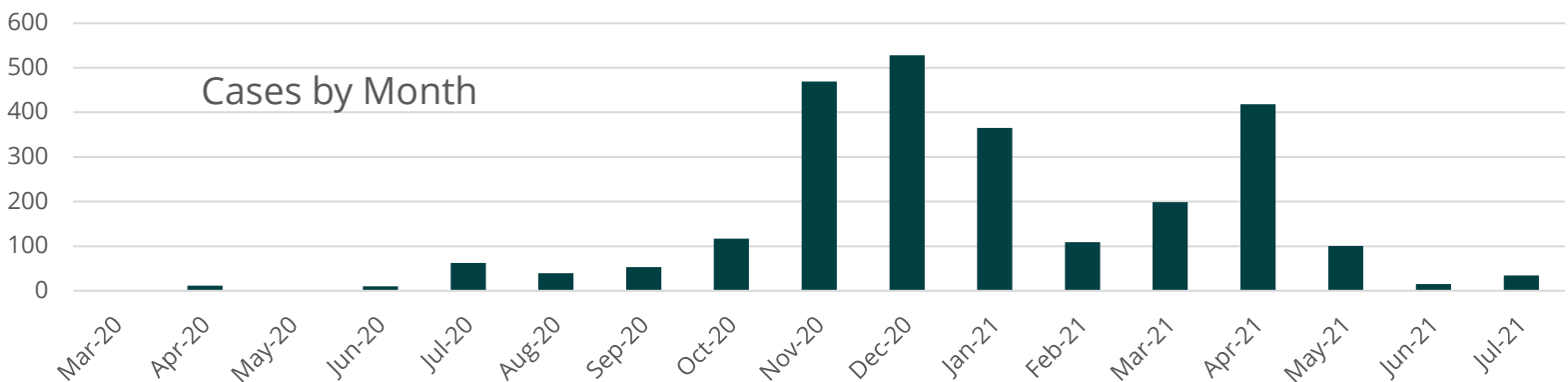
Please note: Symptomatic and Asymptomatic are both contagious
