

What brand of COVID-19 vaccine did you receive in the past?

Pfizer

How long ago did you receive your second dose?

Less than 6 months:

Are you severely immunocompromised due to disease or immunosuppressive drug therapies, or has your care provider recommended that you receive an additional dose of the COVID-19 vaccine?

- Yes. You may receive a dose today if it has been at least 28 days since your 2nd dose.
- No. You may be eligible for a booster six months after your 2nd dose.

More than 6 months:

Do you qualify to receive a booster because of any of the following?

1. Are you 65 years or older? Yes, you may receive a booster shot.
2. Are you 18-64 years of age with an underlying medical condition? Yes, you may receive a booster shot.
3. Are you 18-64 years of age and are at increased risk for COVID-19 exposure and infection because of your occupational or residential setting? Yes, you may receive a booster shot



Moderna

Are you severely immunocompromised due to disease or immunosuppressive drug therapies, or has your care provider recommended that you receive an additional dose of the COVID-19 vaccine?

- Yes. You may receive an additional dose today if it has been at least 28 days since your 2nd dose.
- No. Booster doses are not recommended at this time.



No additional or booster doses are currently recommended for people who received a J&J shot.
